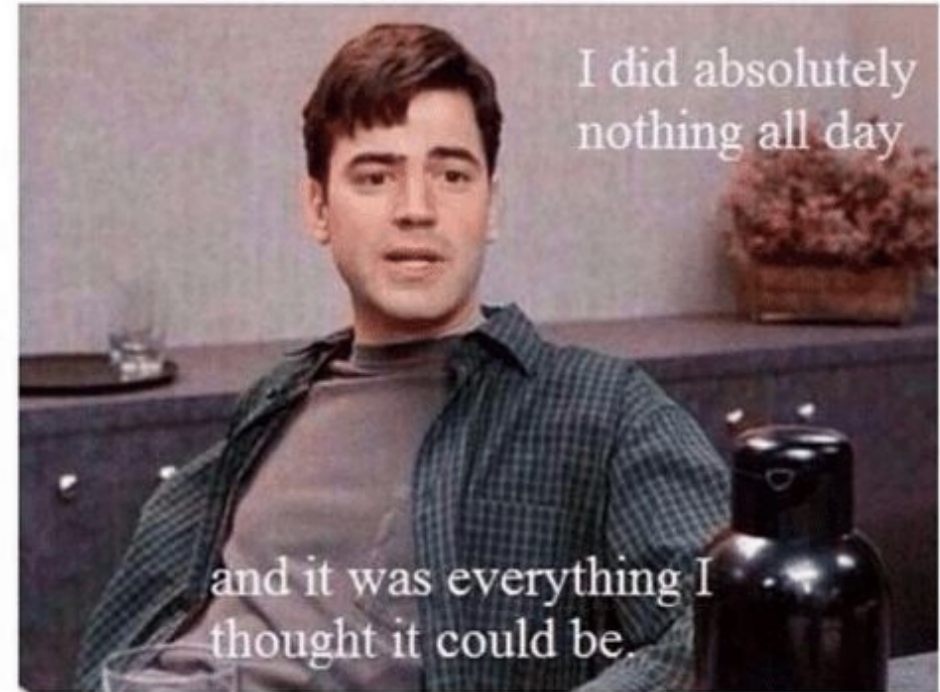

CLASS MATERIALS - REMINDER

- Blue or black pens
- Red Pen
- No. 2 Pencils (mechanical or wooden)
- Highlighters
- 1 Pocket Folder for class OR a section in your binder
- 1 notebook or comp book for class
- **Your Chromebook and charger**

• You need to bring these materials with you to class every day

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- **How do you ask or answer questions?**
 - Language must be appropriate and respectful of others in the class – no cursing/swearing.
- **What should you do BEFORE entering the classroom?**
 - *Before* the bell rings
 - Get out your notebook/compbook
 - Begin the bellwork
- **Sharpen your Pencil if needed**
 - Make sure you have something to write with (pencils, pens in blue or black ink!)
- **Be seated!**
 - You will be counted as **TARDY** if you are not in your seat when the bell rings
 - If you arrive and are tardy, **SILENTLY** go to your seat and look at the board to figure out what we are doing

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- **SILENTLY** complete your bell work
 - What can you do after you finish?
- **Asking questions**
 - Do not approach my desk or ask questions during bell work time
- **Leaving your seat - *when should you? (NOT during instructional time)***
- **Bathroom**
 - All students are expected to use the bathroom in-between classes. Students will only be dismissed to the bathroom in case of extreme emergency.
 - Your agenda must be filled out **PRIOR** to asking to use the restroom - date, time, and end location (bathroom, nurse, front office, etc)

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- **Food *is* permitted in class**
 - As long as it is not a distraction
 - You must clean up after yourself
 - Don't make a mess!
- **End of class**
 - The last two minutes of class will be dedicated to review and writing down classroom assignments for the next day. When the bell rings, you are expected to remain seated, and wait to be dismissed by the teacher. The bell does NOT dismiss you - I do.

CLASSROOM EXPECTATIONS

- **Absent Work**
 - If you are absent, check the absent folders before or after class
 - If you have questions, ask me for clarification
 - Check google classroom when you are absent!
- **Turning in late work**
 - Turn in your late work into the appropriate hours folder
 - I will check and grade late work once a week

CELL PHONE POLICY
