




AXUM, CHANA, ZIMBABWE, MALI, & SONCHAI The Kingdom of Mali flourished from 1200 to 1500

 Trade route


 Mali was visited by the great explorer Ibn Battuta









- Mali was led by <u>Mansa Musa</u>

- He brought back <u>scholars</u> & <u>artists</u>











- The Songhai Empire reached its height from 1450 to 1600
- They conquered the <u>Mali</u> Empire










