





KEY PRINCIPLES ESTABLISHED AT VIENNA

- <u>Metternich</u> had three goals at the Congress:
- l. prevent future French
 <u>aggression</u> & surround
 France w/stronger
 countries
- 2. restore a <u>balance</u>of power (no one country is a threat)
- restore <u>legitimacy</u>: Europe's royal families back on thrones



CONGRESS OF VIENNA WANTS TO GO BACK TO BEFORE THE FRENCH REVOLUTION

<u>Balance of power</u> - no country in Europe too powerful

<u>A new map</u> of Europe drawn (France weaker)


<u>Congress of Vienna:</u> (1815) Peace Conference after Napoleon (Metternich = leader)


<u>Kings</u> restored to power



CHANGES MADE AT VIENNA • <u>France</u> was deprived of all territory conquered by <u>Napoleon</u>

- <u>Austrian</u> Netherlands & Dutch Republic united to form Kingdom of <u>Netherlands</u>
- A <u>Germanic</u> Confederation of 39 states (including <u>Prussia</u>) was created from the previous 300, under Austrian rule
- <u>Switzerland</u> became independent
- Kingdom of <u>Sardinia</u> strengthened by adding Genoa (Italy)







RESULTS OF THE CONGRESS OF VIENNA

LE CONGRES.

- Went easy on <u>France</u> b/c afraid they would want <u>revenge</u> → gave up conquered areas, but kept previous borders
- No <u>country</u> in Europe could easily <u>overpower</u> another
- <u>Fair</u>enough for countries not to hold a <u>grudge</u>
- •Peace lasted <u>38 years</u> & effects on world would be seen for next <u>100 years</u>!
