CATHOLIC Reformation

- The Counter Reformation was the Catholic Church's response to the growing Protestant Reformation.



COUNCIL OF TRENT

- The primary purpose of the council was to refute the beliefs of the Protestants
 - Martin Luther and John Calvin
- The Pope led the Council



COUNCIL OF TRENT

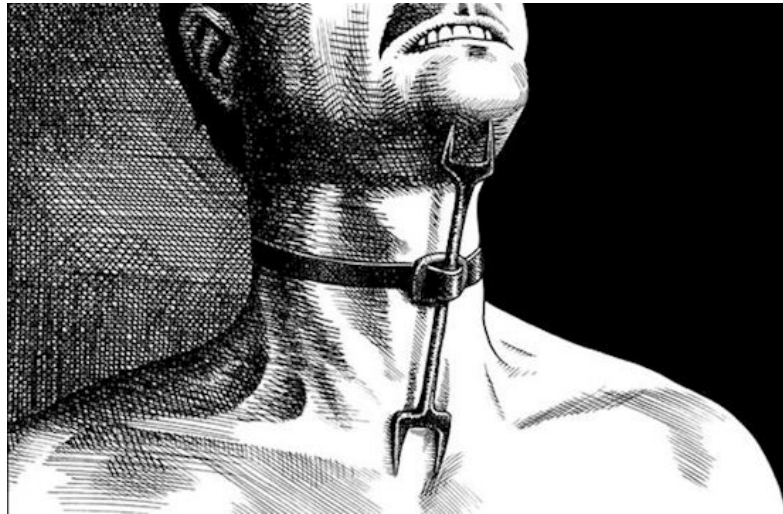
- Reaffirmed Catholic views
 - Salvation comes through faith and good works
 - Bible is not the only source of God's word
 - Penalties for clergy to disobey



EMPOWERING THE INQUISITION

- The Inquisition was created to fight Protestantism
 - The Inquisition was a Church court set up during the Middle Ages.
- They used secret testimony, torture, and execution to root out heresy
 - Heresy: belief not in line with Catholicism

FOUNDING OF Jesuits



- In 1540 the Society of Jesuits were formed
- Ignatius of Loyola was the leader
 - From Spain
- The Jesuit order was dedicated to combating heresy and spreading the Catholic faith.
- Led by Ignatius, the Jesuits led the Crusades to defend Catholicism
- Created schools to enforce Catholic ideas
 - Rockhurst

- Many Catholics experienced renewed feelings of intense faith
- When she entered the covenant she did not find it strict enough
- She devoted herself to the reformation
- So Teresa went and lived in isolation, she ate and slept very little
- Impressed by her spiritual life, Church superiors asked Teresa to reorganize and reform Spanish convents and monasteries.

Legacy of the Catholic Reformation



- The majority of Europeans remained Catholic
- Appreciation for literature and art grew
- Charity flourished and church abuses were reduced
- Witch hunts and the persecution of Jews increased
- Europe was divided by religious ideas
