




Literature

- Literature <u>flourished</u> during the Renaissance
- This can be greatly attributed to <u>Johannes</u> <u>Gutenberg</u>
- In 1455 Gutenberg printed the first book produced by using moveable type.

The <u>Bible</u>



Desiderius Erasmus


- Pushed for a Vernacular form of the Bible
- Used <u>humor</u> to show the immoral and ignorant behavior of people, including the <u>clergy</u>.
- He felt people should be open minded and be kind to <u>others</u>.



Sir Thomas More

- English Humanist
- Wrote: Utopia; A book about a <u>perfect</u> society
- Believed men and women live in <u>harmony</u>.
- No private property, no one is lazy, all people are educated and the justice system is used to end crime instead of executing criminals.





- Wrote <u>The Prince</u> a handbook for princes and kings on <u>ruling</u>
- He supported <u>absolute</u> power
- Believed that the ends <u>iustify</u> the means
- Urged people to try to do good, but do <u>evil</u> if necessary

New Ideas


- individualism emphasis on person as individual rather than part of a group
- <u>secularism</u> focus on <u>worldly</u> themes instead of religious



1455, Johann Gutenburg printed the first edition of the Bible

This would transform Europe

- Books were <u>cheaper</u> and easier to produce
- 2. More people could access knowledge
- 3. Increased <u>education</u> meant people could get better <u>jobs</u>

- Studied law and religion
- Became a doctor
- Was known as a comic and use of satire
