


- French writer on:

- "I disapprove of what you say, but I will defend to the death your right to say it"


Voltaire

- Government must protect our natural rights
 - "All people have the natural rights, including <u>life</u>, <u>liberty</u>, and property.



Montesquieu


- French writer of <u>On the</u>
 <u>Spirit of Laws</u>
- Separation of powers
- To become truly great, one has to stand with people, not above them."






Thomas Hobbes

- English writer of <u>Leviathan</u>
- People are naturally wicked
- Government must keep order
 - "Without
 government our
 lives would be
 nasty, brutish,
 and short!"



Jean Jacques Rousseau

- French writer of <u>The</u>
 <u>Social Contract</u>
- Government is an agreement or contract between ruler & people
- "No man has any natural authority over his fellow men."



Mary Wollstonecraft



- English advocate for women's rights
- Wrote A <u>Vindication</u> of the Rights of Woman
 - Strengthen the female mind by enlarging it, and there will be an end to blind obedience.
