APPEASEMENT

a governmental policy of making political or material concessions to an enemy power in order to avoid conflict





ATOMIC BOMB

weapon with great explosive power that results from the sudden release of energy upon the splitting of the nuclei of heavy elements







FASCISM

Centralized government, not communist, emphasizes the state over the individual. Destructive to human rights.




PACIFISM
