# APPEASEMENT

a governmental policy of making political or material concessions to an enemy power in order to avoid conflict

# PACIFISM

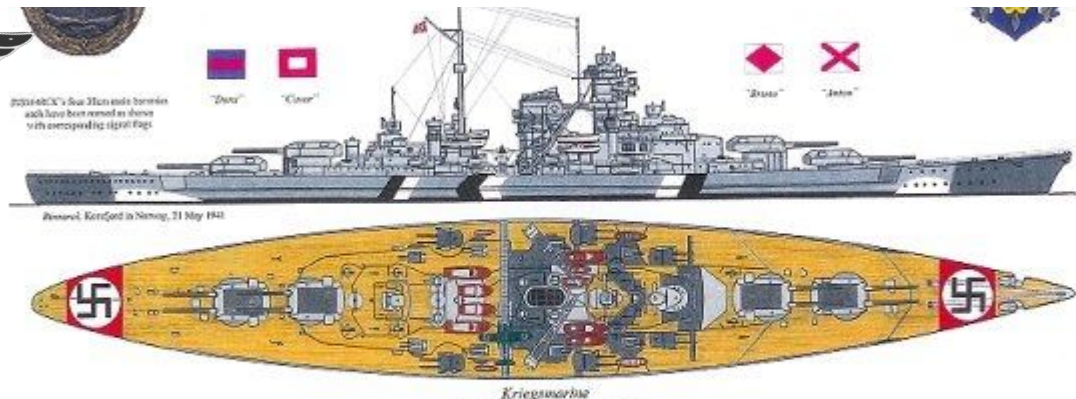
ethical opposition to violence or war, except in cases where force is deemed absolutely necessary to advance the cause of peace
