

Causes of WW2




Political Instability in Germany

- Worldwide depression




Fascism

- No individual freedom


I STEPS TO MASCISM

- 1. Invoke a threat.
- 2. Establish secret prisons.
- 3. Develop a paramilitary force.
- 4. Surveil ordinary citizens.
- 5. Infiltrate citizen's groups.
- 6. Arbitrarily detain citizens.
- 7. Target key individuals.
- 8. Restrict the press.
- 9. Cast dissent as treason.
- 10. Subvert the rule of law.
- 11. Disarm the citizen.
